

JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION-2013, ODISHA (OJEE-2013)

NOTICE - Counselling for Admission to MBBS/BDS Courses

All the registered NEET-UG -2013 qualified rank holders in the Medical Stream (MBBS/BDS) who are permanent natives of Odisha are requested to attend a centralized counselling at **The Institution of Engineers(India), Odisha State Centre, Sachivalaya Marg, (In front of Red Cross Bhawan) Bhubaneswar** during 22-25, July, 2013 for filling up MBBS/BDS seats in different Government and Private Medical Colleges. **The detail rank wise schedule is being notified shortly.**

All MBBS/BDS admissions to the 85% state quota will be done from NEET-UG qualified permanent natives of Odisha candidates only, except in NRI category and for few seats in BDS stream in Hi-Tech Dental College, Bhubaneswar

Seats Available for Counselling* :- MBBS : SCB, Cuttack-212, MKCG, Berhampur-128, VSS, Burla-128, HiTech, Bhubaneswar -100, HiTech, Rourkela-100, SRMCH, Jaring, Kalahandi - 100, **BDS :** SCBDCH, Cuttack - 42, HiTech DCH, Bhubaneswar - 100

*The seats mentioned above include General, SC, ST, GC, PC, ES, NRI (for Private colleges) and WODC category.

Fee Structure :

- Government Medical Colleges : Tuition and other ancillary fees-Rs.20,000/- per annum. Security Deposit (One time during admission)-Rs.10,000/-
- Private Medical Colleges : As decided by the Fee Structure Committee for Private Medical Colleges of the State.

For 10% of seats reserved for WODC candidates in SRMCH, Jaring, the fee structure will be 40% less than the usual fees.

For admission into MBBS/BDS course in Govt. colleges and MBBS course in Private Colleges, the parents of the candidates must be permanent natives of Odisha and must produce permanent residence certificate (http://www.odishajee.com/counselling_brochure_ojee_2013.pdf) at the time of document verification during counselling. The certificate must mention "Native of Odisha"

Reservation Policy :

(a) 8% seats in all colleges are reserved for candidates belonging to Schedule Caste by birth (not by marriage or adoption). 12% seats in all colleges are reserved for candidates belonging to Schedule Tribe by birth (not by marriage or adoption). Candidates applying for SC/ST reserved category shall furnish SC/ST certificate from the Tahasildar of the place of birth in Odisha at the time of document verification in the format given in this counselling brochure (http://www.odishajee.com/counselling_brochure_ojee_2013.pdf).

NOTE : Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe persons who have migrated from their state of origin to another state for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc., will be deemed to be scheduled caste/ tribe of the state of their origin and will be entitled to derive benefits from the state of origin and not from the state to which they have migrated. (Vide Govt. of India Letter No. BC/160 14. 1.82 SC & BCD/ dated 22nd Feb, 1985). Thus, SC/ST candidates from Odisha who are staying outside the State have to produce SC/ST certificate from the competent authority of Odisha State during document verification.

(b) 5% of seats are reserved for children of Green Card holders. Candidates applying under Green Card category shall furnish the Green card of their parents issued by Family Welfare Department, Government of Odisha/any other appropriate authority, in original at the time of document verification. The name, date of birth of the candidate alongwith the parents' names should match with those mentioned in 10th class pass certificate. If in future it is found that the green card has been obtained by providing wrong information or suppressing facts, the card holder will be deprived of the facilities already obtained and will be liable for legal punitive action.

(c) 3% of total MBBS and BDS seats are reserved for persons with disabilities (PC category) and they have to meet the medical standard of Locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50 to 70% (% of disability may vary subject to the decision of the Hon'ble Apex court).

Further, for MBBS/BDS stream, the candidates claiming locomotory disabilities of lower limbs are only eligible for consideration. Visually handicapped and hearing disabled candidates are not eligible as stipulated by Medical Council of India.

The medical standard of PC category candidates is decided by a medical board specifically constituted with Senior Professors of the premier medical college and hospital: SCB Medical College, Cuttack, and Chairman OJEE-2013 or his representative under the Chairmanship of Principal, SCB Medical College or his nominee, that they are eligible to be categorized as Physically Challenged candidates and capable of undergoing the requirements for MBBS / BDS. The decision of this Board is final and binding. They SHOULD NOT therefore, submit any medical certificate to the effect that they are physically Challenged during document verification of the counselling.

(d) 3% seats in Government Medical Colleges in MBBS and BDS courses are reserved for children/widows of ex-servicemen who are natives of Odisha. Candidates applying under Ex-Serviceman reserved category shall furnish a certificate in the prescribed format provided in (http://www.odishajee.com/counselling_brochure_ojee_2013.pdf) at the time of document verification. The allotment under this category will be done based on the prioritization obtained from Raja Saink Board. The decision of this Board is final and binding.

(e) NRI seats (15% of seats within sanctioned intake but 5% in case of SRMCH, Jaring, Bhawanipatna) are available only for the private colleges.

Seats vacant after NRI counseling in Private Medical Colleges shall be filled up from the General category candidates of the NEET-UG list of qualified candidates

NRI means Sons and Daughters of an Indian citizen who ordinarily reside outside India and hold an Indian passport.

The candidate eligible to avail NRI category must produce at the time of document verification

- Copies of passport
- Work permit
- Equivalence certificate of the qualifying examination..

Students admitted under this scheme shall not be allowed to change Institution / course under any circumstances.

(f) Outside state candidates (ZZ) are eligible for BDS stream in private professional colleges.

(g) 10% seats in Hi-Tech Medical College, Rourkela and Sardar Raja Medical College & Hospital (SRMCH), Jaring, Kalahandi shall be filled up from the WODC category NEET qualified candidates. Seats vacant if any after WODC counseling shall be again filled up from the General category candidates of the NEET-UG list of qualified candidates. WODC candidates must belong to Western Odisha Development Council (WODC) area incorporating 10 districts, namely Boudh, Bargarh, Bolangir, Deogarh, Kalahandi, Nuapada, Jharsuguda, Sambalpur, Subarnapur, Sundargarh and Athamallik subdivision (Kishore Nagar and Athamallik Tahsils) of Angul district.

Therefore for allotment of the seats to the candidates, the reservations applicable are as given below from the balance seats after deducting NRI and WODC seats from the total intake as applicable for private colleges only.

For MBBS and BDS the reservation is as given below :

Scheduled Caste	8%
Scheduled Tribe	12%
Green Card	5%
Physically Challenged	3%
Ex-Servicemen	3% (Only applicable for Government colleges)

If eligible candidates belonging to a reserved category are not available, seats can be filled up by the candidates belonging to the general category.

Age : The candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31-12-2013 as per MCI Rules

Eligibility in the Qualifying Examination :

- General Category :** Must have Passed 10+2 Science and Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English with 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology.
- SC/ST Category :** Must have Passed 10+2 Science and Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English with 40% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology
- PC Category :** Must have Passed 10+2 Science and Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English with 45% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology

Vital points

- The registration of NEET-UG 2013 candidates for MBBS/BDS stream under OJEE 2013 is open till 21st July, 2013 at www.odishajee.com.
- All the interested left over candidates under General, SC, ST, GC, PC, ES, NRI (for Private colleges) and WODC category are requested to register in the above website.
- The candidate must have valid NEET-UG 2013 rank card to participate in this counselling.
- All the candidates have to report to the counselling center as per their All India NEET-UG 2013 rank.
- All the candidates have to verify their documents during counselling as per the list given below.
- All the candidates appearing for document verification in this counseling have to deposit the non-refundable counseling fee of Rs. 950/- in the form of DD in favour of "OJEE-2013" payable at Bhubaneswar.
- All the candidates have to pay non-refundable University Registration Fee Rs.5,000/- in the form of DD in favour of "OJEE-2013" payable at Bhubaneswar during document verification.
- If a candidate does not report during scheduled date and time of reporting for counseling, he/she will be treated as absentee and will not be permitted to participate in the counselling subsequently under any circumstances.
- All candidates must produce nativity certificate in the counselling process
